



Completed projects:

- 17 Facilities Countywide
- 5 Mechanically Operated
- Over 4 Billion Gallons (Floodwaters) Diverted
- Additional Benefits Provided by Temporarily Storing Flood Waters in Forest Preserve
- Incorporated Water Quality & Environmental Improvements where Practical
- Annual Budget (Maintenance & Operations) \$2.69 Million
 - Flood Forecasting
 - Stream Maintenance
 - Flood Control Operations
 - Facility Maintenance








April 2013 flood severely affected the DuPage County communities.

- Damage Reports/Claims over 9000 structures
- Insurance claims and loans totaled more than \$65 million
 - Ongoing recovery efforts include:
 - Home & business repairs
 - Flood-prone property buyouts
 - Flood mitigation projects
 - Ongoing Resiliency Efforts Include

 - Education and Outreach on Residential Flood awareness & flood proofing
