

The purpose of the project

- Improve the capability of the sanitary sewage system along Porter Avenue within the Town of Chesterton in Porter County, Indiana.
- The additional reliability of the sewer system would alleviate occasional storm water overflow problems affecting the wastewater treatment plant which impacts the approximately 13,000 people that live in Chesterton..



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The construction contract was awarded in April 2010 to Contractor United Services Authority, LLC for \$180,000. The project cost was cost shared 75% Federal and 25% Non-Federal (Town of Chesterton.) The construction was completed on October 2010.
