

Project Description:

The work includes installation of new storm sewers, drainage structures, water mains and sanitary sewer adjustments that would also include resurfacing of West Street between Robinson Ct. and Anderson St.

Project cost and agreement:

This project is being completed in accordance with the signed greement between the U S Army Corps of Engineers, Chicago District and the City of Crown Point. The signed agreement cost share is 75% USACE and 25% City of Crown Point. The total project cost is \$2,125,000.

Project benefit:

The proposed project would improve the efficiency and capability of the storm sewer management system within the City of Crown Point (120,000 in population) in Lake County, Indiana. The current storm sewer system is in need of improvements that would alleviate the common flooding currently caused by typical rainfall events. Waterline replacement and upgrades would insure residents have a reliable water supply.

Construction contract

A construction contract was awarded to Rausch Construction Company, Inc for \$1,712,918.00 on September 29, 2011. Construction activities began early spring 2012 and construction was completed in July 2012. The construction contract was completed on time and under budget.
