Explain: **Farmed Wetland 1 drains towards Wetland 2, where the property suddenly rises 3-4 feet in elevation, ponding water. Wetland 3 forms from stormwater discharge pipe off of Rt. 64 and ponds in the woods. Off-Site Wetland 1 forms from stormwater discharge pipe off of Rt. 64 and ponds along the roadside ditch. Wetland 4 forms from roadside ditch run-off from along Rt. 64 and ponds in the corner of the site. Wetland 1 takes surface sheet flow runoff from the farm, and ponds in the NW corner; and only in extreme rain events will drain north into another wetland.**
