PROJECT PURPOSE

The proposed project would repair the existing leaks and extend the life of select portions of the Sanitary sewer system within the City of East Chicago in Lake County, Indiana. Sanitary sewer system construction improvements would alleviate the leakage from the sanitary sewer system and the resulting basement flooding affecting this residential area.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project will reline the existing sanitary sewer system in the City of East Chicago, at the following locations: Tod Ave from Johnson Street to 140th St, Baring Ave from 145th to Columbus Dr, and Indianapolis Blvd from Chicago Ave to 148th St. The sewer will be relined with Cured-in-Place Piping, to reduce infiltration of storm water into East Chicago's sanitary sewer system. This project is part of the Calumet Region Environmental Infrastructure Section 219 project Authority, and has been allocated \$700,000 of Federal funding.

PROJECT AUTHORITY

The project is authorized under Section 219 of the Water Resources Development Act (WRDA) 1992, as amended by Section 504 of WRDA 1996, Section 502 of WRDA 1999, and by Section 108 of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2001. Section 219, as amended, allows the Army Corps of Engineers to provide planning, design and construction assistance for carrying out water-related environmental infrastructure projects in select areas. The project under this authority are cost shared 75% Federal and 25% Non-Federal Sponsor.

CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT INFORMATION

Contract was awarded to VISU-SEWER CLEAN & SEAL, INC. of Pewaukee Wisconsin on September 27, 2012 in the amount of \$652,628.00. Field construction work is projected to begin in May 2013.
