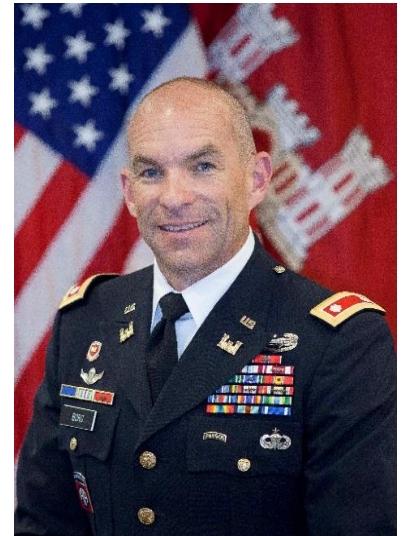

**Lt. Col. Jason Borg
Chicago District
Deputy Commander**



As the deputy commander of the Chicago District, Lt. Col. Jason Borg assists the district commander in water resources development in the Chicago metropolitan area, an area of about 5,000 square miles with a population of more than nine million. The district's primary mission focuses on flood risk management and storm damage reduction, navigation, environment, regulatory, navigation, emergency management, and interagency and international services.

Lt. Col. Borg was commissioned as an Engineer Officer after graduating from the University of Washington in 1996. His first assignment was with the 16th Engineer Battalion in Germany as an Engineer Platoon Leader, and he deployed to Bosnia in support of SFOR in 1998. From 2000-2004 Lt. Col. Borg served in the 307th Engineer Battalion, Fort Bragg NC as a Brigade Engineer and then a Bravo Company Commander while deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. Lt. Col. Borg was then assigned to the Army's National Training Center located at Fort Irwin, Calif. From 2008-2012 he served with the 10th Mountain Division, Fort Drum, NY as a Deputy Division Engineer, a Battalion Operations Officer, and a Battalion Executive Officer. Lt. Col. Borg deployed twice during this time, once in 2008 to Iraq as the Multi-National Division Center Basing Officer, and again in 2011 to Afghanistan. In 2012, he returned to Fort Bragg serving with the XVIII Airborne Corps as a Future Operations Planner, and the Deputy Corps Engineer where he deployed to Kabul, Afghanistan in 2014 serving as the ISAF Joint Command Assistant Chief Basing officer. In 2015 Lt. Col. Borg assumed command of the 30th Engineer Battalion (Provisional) and inactivated the battalion in November 2015. His final assignment at Fort Bragg was serving as the Deputy Commander for the 20th Engineer Brigade.

Lt. Col. Borg is a graduate of multiple Army courses and schools including the Army's Intermediate Learning Education Course at the Command and General Staff College; and the Army's Engineer Officer Basic Course and Engineer Captains Career Courses; Ranger, Airborne, and the Advanced Airborne School. He is currently pursuing his Masters in Organizational Leadership from Gonzaga University, and has a Bachelor in Business Administration (Finance) from the University of Washington.

His military awards and decorations include three Bronze Star Medals, the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, five Meritorious Service Medals, two Army Commendation Medals, two Army Achievement Medals, the Ranger Tab, the Senior Parachutist Badge and Combat Action Badge.
