<u>CHICAGO HARBOR LOCK</u> AMENDED CLOSURE SCHEDULE FOR GATE REPAIRS

- 1. Navigation Notice 12-001 is hereby cancelled. The following amended closure schedule is necessary to complete the repairs to the gate machinery of all four lock gates:
- 2. The present closure of Chicago Harbor Lock to all navigation has been extended until approximately 02 April 2012 to complete installation of the north gates machinery.
- 3. As soon as the north gates are operational, one short duration window of a few hours will be provided for a 78 ft width lockage of larger vessels. Mariners desiring this special lockage must schedule the lockage with Chicago District Operations to coordinate the exact date & time of the transit window and restriction information. The anticipated date is 02 or 03 April 2012.
- 4. From the end of the 78 ft wide transit window until 7 A.M. on 28 April 2012, the Chicago Harbor Lock will operate with a 40 feet width restriction for the repair of the south gates. Vessels may be delayed up to 4 hours when certain work is in progress. Mariners are encouraged to contact lock operators 24/7 by phone 312-787-4795 to discuss lockage timing.
- 5. Commencing at 7 A.M. on 28 April 2012, there will be a complete closure of the Chicago Harbor Lock until 7 A.M. on 01 May 2012.
- 6. From 7 A.M. on 01 May 2012 until repairs are completed currently scheduled for 7 P.M. on 15 May 2012 the lock will generally operate with a 40 feet wide width restriction, and completely close to all vessels each night from 1 A.M. to 9 A.M. In addition, there will be one all-day lock closure to all vessels target date is 02 or 03 May 2012. A separate notice will be issued as soon as the work date is confirmed to provide specific information to boatyards and crews.
