The environmental assessment for the proposed stormwater improvement project in the Village of Richton Park, IL is available for review. The assessment, entitled The Village of Richton Park Stormwater Improvement Project is located at the following address:

The proposed project includes the construction of a 1.7 acre detention basin at the upstream end of the East Branch of Butterfield Creek within Village limits to improve flooding conditions downstream. In addition to construction of the detention basin, an outlet pipe that would extend approximately 600 LF from the detention basin to the East Branch of Butterfield Creek would be constructed and restoration of an approximately 900 LF reach of the East Branch of Butterfield Creek.

As part of the NEPA review process, the Chicago District would appreciate any comments or concerns you might have about potential impacts from this proposed project. This could include impacts to wetlands, rare and unique habitats, threatened and endangered species, or cultural and social resources.
