Explain: **Drainageway 1 was constructed in a sloped hydric soil feature, starting from the Stormwater Management Aera (which was formerly a farmed wetland), and draining into Wetland 3, a low spot in the farm field; and when Wetland 3 fills up with water, it starts to drain out Drainageway 2, which was also cut in the sloped hydric soil feature. This entire length of sloped hydric soil is likely underlain by an old farm tile system, and after reviewing all the available aerial photographs, there is no evidence of overland flow ever reaching the culvert under Pulaski Road that leads to Butterfield Creek. Wetland 2 is a shallow depressional feature separate from Wetland 1, and has no connection to the culvert under Butterfield Road. Wetland 4 and Wetland 5 are both former farmed wetlands that are now vegetated, but are shallow impoundments at the edge of the farm field at the forest buffer strip; and they do not drain off-site..**
